

Future Parks Now

Last year three parks from Bucharest, Pitesti and Moinesti were refurbished in the spirit of the respect for the future. This year, the social responsibility project *Parks of the Future* continues through the refurbish of another two parks: The Teenagers Park in Timisoara and Liberty Park in Ploiesti.

The start to the refurbish works at the two parks was given on 17 June 2008 in Ploiesti and 1 June 2008 in Timisoara in the presence of Petrom's representatives, local authorities and mass media. Mona Nicolici, CSR Communication Manager Petrom and Dana Ichim, CSR Manager Petrom, together with the representatives of the mayors in the two cities, symbolically began the work at the parks.

The Teenagers Park in Timisoara, with an area of 10 000 m², will be transformed into a modern space where everyone can relax and find oneself in a natural environment. In Ploiesti, The Liberty Park, with an area of 32 000 m², will commemorate 130 years from the first steam locomotive in the town. The past will be connected to the present by the numerous devices that make use of unconventional energy and are placed in the park.

Petrom volunteers and local community volunteers will help refurbish the two parks.
